PRESIDENT: Chuck Tice 372 Central Park West. PWVTA offices: former Corresponding Secretary, Secretary, Building Rep, Alternate Rep & Building Coordinator, Grievance Committee Chair, Social Activities Committee Co-chair, Publications Committee Chair; current Acting Chair of Communications Committee; Chair, Web Subcommittee of Communications Committee. Non-PWVTA: Federation of Citywide Block Associations, Executive Director; NYC Coalition of Neighborhood Associations, Exec. Director.

VICE PRESIDENT: Dorri Jacobs 784 Columbus Avenue. PWV resident since 1970, Dorri is currently PWVTA Secretary, a position she has held since 2004. As VP, her aims are to clarify tenant concerns, improve communications, and set a positive tone. She says: "With development eroding our community, our continued success depends on your membership and participation. PWVTA protects our rights, addresses quality-of-life issues, and joins with other groups to save affordable housing.

Chair Overcharge Subcommittee providing ongoing assistance to new tenants who file overcharge complaints to the NYS Division of Housing and Community Renewal; successful results include monetary awards to tenants and restoration of market-rent apartments to Rent Stabilization. Member of NYS Tenants and Neighbors and involved in city-wide affordable housing campaigns. Active in affordable housing issues since mid-1960's. Former VISTA Volunteer.
